In 1986, he was awarded a Fellowship at the Rothman Institute in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, in adult reconstructive surgery, specializing in the surgical treatment of the arthritic hip and knee. During his fellowship year, Dr. Gordon performed numerous primary and complex revision hip and knee replacement surgeries with Dr. Richard Rothman and Dr. Robert Booth.**
